## Certificate Programs Hands-on Filmmaking, Documentary, and Screenwriting

Students receive 2.4 Continuing Education Units for each Hands-on Filmmaking or Screenwriting class that they finish. Students who complete the Seattle Film Institute's core sequence of Filmmaking/Documentary I-IV or Screenwriting I-IV and a Film History class receive the Hands-On Certificate of Completion. This certificate represents a formal validation of the student's filmmaking competence and the acknowledgement that the student has successfully finished a five-course sequence representing 12 Continuing Education Units and 120 direct contact hours.
